

DRAFT CHRONOLOGY OF EOC OPERATIONS, DEC 2 - 9, 2007

EOC Operational Hours:

Dec 3 - 0400 - 1900 from PCSO LB

Dec 4 - 0400 through Dec 6 2100 hours (24 hours/day)

Dec 7 - 0745 - 2100

Dec 8 - 0900 - 2100

Dec 9 - 1230 - 1730

Notes: 157 welfare checks were handled by dispatch, 35 went through the EOC. In addition the EOC traced and tracked rumors, including water contamination, deaths, etc.

Dispatch processed over 650 calls for service during the storm, while short staffed.
