An interagency debriefing meeting was held 12/11/07 in South bend regarding local agencies' response to the recent storm event in Pacific County. You may find a chronology of EOC operations on the Pacific County Websites listed below.

Copies of these documents are also available at the Sheriff's Office in Long Beach and South Bend. Representatives from all branches of local government attended as well as the WSDOT, The American Red Cross, and The Shoalwater Tribe Emergency Manager.

The goal of debriefing was to highlight what worked, what didn't, and identify ways to enhance interagency cooperation. Many ideas for improving service were discussed

After the public has had time to review this information, town hall meetings in January will be held throughout the county to share information and gain your perspectives and ideas to enhance our services.

After we receive your input, coupled with response agency ideas for improvement, we will incorporate those suggestions into our All Hazards Emergency Response Plan.

We look forward to meeting with you, answering your questions about existing plans and operations and brainstorming ways to improve public safety in future emergencies in Pacific County.
